कार्य - 19 महीनारी की रिश्ति में परीक्षा संचालन हेतु विद्या विद्यालय अयुधान आयोग द्वारा जारी दिनांक 6/7/2020 को जारी दिशा निर्देश एवं दलीसगद मासन उच्य भिशा विभाग द्वारा दिनांक 30/7/2020 को जारी निर्देशों के परिपालन में सर्व सम्मति से विभिन्न विन्दुओं पर निम्नानुसार निर्णय लिया गया -

1. चतुर्थ सेमेस्टर नियमित एवं सहायिक प्रायोगिक एवं लघुगोष्ठा मूल्यांकन एवं मॉरिक्की ऑनलाईन मोड में संचालित होंगे।

2. एम. ए., एम. एस. सी., एम. काम प्रथम द्वितीय एवं हातीय सेमेस्टर ATKT के परीक्षार्थियों को उनके संबन्धित प्रश्न-पत्र में आन्तरिक मूल्यांकन के प्राप्तांक के समानुपातिक अंक प्रदान किया जायेगा।

3. द्वितीय सेमेस्टर नियमित छात्रों को उनके संबन्धित प्रश्न-पत्र में आन्तरिक मूल्यांकन के प्राप्तांक एवं प्रथम सेमेस्टर के संबन्धित प्रश्न-पत्र के प्राप्तांक के 50% 50% अधिकार प्रदान करते हुए अथवा 50-50 अंक के समानुपातिक अंक प्रदान किये जाएं। समानुपातिक अंक की गणना हेतु प्राध्यापकों की एक समिति गठित की जायेगी।

The decisions taken unanimously in the ^{of academic council} meetings are as follows:

1. That from Session 2020-2021 all the UG programmes including Law graduation will run under semester system and the first paper of all the subjects in first semester and the second paper of all the subjects will be effective in semester second.
2. Law graduation will run in semester system as usual.
3. The admission in semester classes will be done in accordance to the provisions laid down by Dept. of Higher Education, Govt. of Chhattisgarh.
4. Evaluation will consist of two parts; Internal and semester end examination.
5. The students will complete the course in optimum six years. Diploma courses like PGDCA and DCA will run in annual system.
6. In Each theoretical subject, theoretical paper of 100 marks

- will be comprised of 70 marks semester end examination and 30 marks for internal examination (evaluation)
7. In practical subjects two theoretical papers of 75 marks each and one ^{practical} paper of 50 marks would be there and in theoretical paper 50 marks for semester evaluation and 25 for internal assessment would be there.
8. The syllabus of Mathematics will be adopted as of Govt Science College, Bilaspur and of Chemistry as of Govt. Bilasa Girls P.S. College, Bilaspur. (C.G)
9. In paper of Environmental studies, 100 marks of theoretical paper will be divided into 70 marks Sem. end examination and 30 marks for internal assessment and 50 marks will be allocated to field work/project work, in which a candidate has to submit a project report on environmental conservation work conducted in nearby areas to his village.
10. There is provision for each student to enroll in the value added course, being run in the college, selection one from Sem I to Sem VI. Successful completion of the value added course would be entitled for a certificate of the college. A cell has been constituted to run and maintain the documents as per the instructions laid down by the government.
11. (a). Internal Assessment: Under new semester system in the theoretical papers of theoretical subjects, three tiers internal assessment - 30 marks will be divided as - internal test - 10, Seminar - 10 and assignment - 10 marks. The number of test will be 02 in which the first test two questions of 02 marks ($2 \times 2 = 04$), word limit 100-words of very short answer type questions and 01 short answer type questions of 06 marks ($1 \times 6 = 06$) word limit 200-250 words and will be completed in a

period of 40 minutes. The second test would be multiple choice question.

Assignment - It will be comprised of three tier question in which 02 questions of 01 marks ($2 \times 1 = 02$) word limit 70-100 words of very short answer type questions and 02 short answer type questions of 1.5 marks each ($2 \times 1.5 = 03$) word limit 200-250 words and two long answer type questions of 2.5 marks each ($2 \times 2.5 = 05$ marks) word limit 500-600.

To pass the internal test, it is necessary to obtain 11 marks in all these components (test, seminar and assignment).

(b) In practical subject: theoretical paper internal assessment would be of 25 marks, comprising of 08 marks for test, Seminar - 08 marks and assignment of 09 marks. The number of test will be 02 and set-up of questions will be 02 questions of 02 marks will be short answer type question of 100 words and 01 long answer type questions of 04 marks ($1 \times 4 = 04$) word limit would be 500-600 words.

Assignment - Three tier question pattern for theoretical papers of practical subjects would be there, comprising of 02 very short answer type questions of 01 marks each ($2 \times 1 = 02$) with word limit 70-100 words, 02 questions of short answer type questions of 1.5 marks each ($02 \times 1.5 = 03$ marks) with word limit 200-250 words, and 02 long answer type questions of 02 marks each ($2 \times 2 = 04$) with word limit of 500-600 words.

It is necessary to obtain 09 marks minimum collectively in all these components (test, seminar and assignment).

12. If a student of NCC, NSS and sports has represented in their respective events to institution and he/she has appeared in unit tests in a test, he/she will be awarded the equal marks obtained in the appeared test to the left one. But if she/he has not appeared in any test of any paper then the first unit test of that student of the paper would be organised. No unit test in any condition will be organised excepting representation of students in NCC, NSS and Sports.

Seminar - Paper presentation and paper submission is mandatory. Minimum passing marks in all the three components collectively will be obligatory.

13(a) Semester Exam - Four tier questions of 70 marks for semester classes are prescribed. There would be 10 multiple choice questions of 01 mark each ($10 \times 1 = 10$), there would be 03 very short answer type questions of 03 marks each ($03 \times 03 = 09$) with word limit 70-100, thereby there would 03 short answer type questions of 06 marks each ($03 \times 06 = 18$) with word limit of 200-250 words and lastly there would be 03 questions of 11 marks each ($3 \times 11 = 33$) with word limit 500-600 words. All the questions will be provided with internal choice.

In semester examination minimum passing marks would be 25 in each paper with minimum internal passing marks 11 and in aggregate 36 marks in each paper is mandatory. In law 36 marks in each paper is mandatory and the aggregate of all the papers will be 48% (to be obtained) mandatory.

(b) In theoretical papers of practical subject, out of questions of 50 marks is prescribed, in which there would be 08 multiple choice questions of 01 mark each ($08 \times 01 = 08$), next 03 very short answer type questions of 02 marks each ($03 \times 02 = 06$) with word limit of 70-10 words, next 03 short answer type questions of 04 marks each ($03 \times 04 = 12$) with word limit of 200-250 words and 03 long answer type questions of 08 marks each ($03 \times 08 = 24$) with word limit of 500-600 words. All the questions would be provided with internal choice.

14. Provision of grace marks. There will be provision of maximum 03 marks in maximum 02 subjects/papers to pass. Together with for division or promotion there would eligibility of 01 marks which will not be added in total marks obtained. Both the provisions of grace marks will not be implemented collectively.

15. Constitution of Internal monitoring Committee: Every department will have internal evaluation committee, which will be constituted as - Head of the Dept. as co-ordinator, one member from autonomous would be there as member, one teacher from the Dept. would be member but the Dept. which do not have a regular teacher, there a member out side from the college would be nominated. The test copy will be shown (distributed) among the students and if there is any complaint regarding internal evaluation, the received complaint will be resolved by the Internal Evaluation Monitoring Committee.

16. Revaluation: - There is provision of revaluation in maximum 02 subjects/papers only.

17. Teacher - Guardian Scheme:- Every Head of the Dept. for P.G. classes and other teachers of the Dept. for UG classes will work as teacher-guardian, who will monitor students value added course, Internship and will held meeting with their parents and will collect and maintain the information of placement. Rs. 15 will be collected from regular students in Environmental studies, ^{out of} Rs. 100 which will be paid to teachers for guiding and evaluating environmental project work/field work. Rest Rs. 05 will be paid to autonomous controllers and office staff.

18. Eligibility to appear in the examination:-
- (a) In semester classes 75% with passing in all the subject/papers of internal test separately will be mandatory.
 - (b) The student will be eligible for second semester if he has appeared in the first semester examination with as many papers in back.
 - (c) For admission in third semester:- The student should not be back in more than 02 subjects/papers of first semester and including second semester she/he should not be back in more than 04 subjects/paper in previous both semesters.
 - (e) Eligibility for examination in IVth semester - For appearing in IVth semester the student should not have the backlog in more than 04 subjects/papers in sem I, II and III collectively.
 - (f) Eligibility for admission in Vth semester - For admission in Vth semester the student should be pass in Sem I & Sem II and should not have backlog in more than 02 subjects/papers in Sem III and IV respectively.

- (g) Eligibility for admission in VIth Semester - For admission in VIth semester the student should be pass in Sem I, II and III respectively. Together with he/she should not have the backlog of more than 04 subjects/papers in IVth and Vth semester.
- (h) The back exam of sum semester will be organised with sum semester and of even semester with even semester examination.
- (i) If a student is pass in all semesters excepting back in Vth semester in 01 subject/paper then he will be given chance to appear in that subject/paper of Vth semester with the examination of Vth semester.

19. Eligibility for Law Graduate Classes:-

Eligibility for appearing in the examination I stand together with all other semesters -

- i) Should pass all the papers of internal examination with 75% attendance.
- ii) For passing the examination the student of concerned semester has to obtain 36% in each papers and in aggregate 48% is mandatory.
- iii) The student obtaining less than 36% minimum passing marks will be declared ATKT, such student will be eligible for admission in next semester and will be eligible to appear in the ATKT paper with next semester's examination.
- iv) Such students in each semester who has obtained minimum 36% passing mark but obtained aggregate is less than 48%, they will be declared ATKT short of aggregate. These students will be eligible for admission

in next semester and selecting any 02 papers of the concerned semester will appear in the ATKT examination.

(vi) A student obtaining less than 36% marks in more than 01 papers will be declared fail. These students without passing the concerned semester will neither be entitled for regular admission in the next semester nor will be entitled to appear in the next semester examination.

(vii) Before admission in vth semester a student has to pass all the four semester with aggregate of 48%.

(viii) Only those students will be eligible to appear in vth semester exam who have passed vth semester or ATKT, or ATKT short of aggregate in vth semester. But a student fail in vth semester will not be eligible to appear in the vth semester examination. Such student passing the vth semester will take admission in the vth semester as regular student and will appear in the exam.

(ix) A student absent in practical examination of any semester will be considered absent in the concerned examination and will be eligible to appear in the ATKT exam in the next semester.

(x) A student has to complete the programme in maximum 06 years.

20. Internship Training: - Every student with his course will select an area of interest for internship. Internship cell will be constituted for the purpose which will allocate the firm, person or institution for the internship. A student has to submit/produce the internship certificate in the internship cell of the college.

21. Leaving one course incomplete admission in another: -

In such cases on account of seats available in the class student can be admitted in the class.

22. Filling up of examination form by the students: -

Students have to fill up examination form for appearing in the examination. He has to pass the internal examination and minimum attendance will be 75% for it.

A student will not be eligible to appear in the Semester end examination if he does not pass in the internal assessment of the Semester, if he is student of first semester, he will not be allowed to continue his further study. But if he is in second, third, fourth, fifth and sixth semester, he will be allowed to obtain the minimum passing marks again continuing in the concerned semester. This provision will equally be applicable for Law students.

23. Moderation Board: - Before the final printing of the paper moderation board will scrutinise and ensure that the questions are from the prescribed course and the language and pattern is strictly in accordance to the provision laid down.

Besides the above in any odd situation the provision inherent in the ordinance of BCI and St. Gauri Gauri University, Surguja, Ambikapur will be abiding.

The decisions taken in the meetings are as follows:

1. In first and second semester there would be 03-03 common core course, 01-01 Introductory core course and in third semester two common core course, 01 introductory core course and one introductory vocational ~~core~~ course will be implemented.
2. In fourth semester related to main subject there would be two papers each from disciplinary/ Interdisciplinary subjects, from Interdisciplinary minor course would have one paper and from interdisciplinary minor vocational course one paper will be implemented.
3. In fifth semester there would be three papers from disciplinary major paper, and one each from Interdisciplinary minor paper and Interdisciplinary vocational paper. In practical subject from first to six semester there would be one each practical paper related to disciplinary/ Interdisciplinary major subjects.

4. There would be three papers in sixth semester of disciplinary major paper, one paper from Interdisciplinary minor paper, one from Interdisciplinary vocational paper and one paper from community service will be implemented. Only those students will be eligible for admission in seventh semester who have collectively secured 7.5 CGPA and those who do not secure 7.5 CGPA collectively in six semesters will be provided three years honours degree course.
5. In semester seven and eighth three and two papers as curriculum will be implemented which will be related to research methodology.
6. Scheme of Certificate and degree - (a) Students completing two semester (01 year) will be provided with certificate in the concerned subject.
(b) Students completing four semester (02 years) will be provided with diploma in the concerned subject.
(c) Students completing six semester (03 years) will be provided with honours degree in the concerned subject.
(d) Students completing eight semesters (04 years) will be provided with honours with research in the subject concerned.
07. Commencement of NCC and Law as subject - In semester first session 2022-23 admitted students of Arts and Social Science can opt NCC and Law as elective paper.
08. The students will be provided with the facility to study online courses available on Mooc and

Swayam and the portion matching with the course of the subject, and papers will not be taught in the class rather they will be eligible for appropriate credit after furnishing the certificate in this regard.

02. (a) Internal test for theoretical subjects - There would be three tier internal test of 30 marks in theoretical papers of New semester system, for test 10 marks, Seminar - 10 marks and for assignment 10 marks. There would be two tests and in first test two question of 02 marks, word limit 100 words very short answer type questions and short answer type question would be 01 of six (06) marks with word limit 200-500. The scheduled time for internal test would be 40 minutes period. The second test would of objective type.

Assignment - There will be three tier question scheme in which two questions of 01 marks each and word limit 70 - 100 words, two short answer type questions comprising 1.5 marks each with word limit 200 - 250 words and long answer type 02 questions of 2.5 marks each word limit 500 - 600 words.

(b) Internal test for practical subjects - In theoretical papers of practical subjects internal test will be of 25 marks in which 08 marks for test, 08 marks for seminar and 09 marks for assignment. There will be two internal test in which 02 questions of 02 marks each comprising of 100 words short answer type questions and 01 question of 04 marks long answer type question of 500 - 600 words.

Assignment - In theoretical papers of practical subjects

there will be three tier questions in which 02 very short answer type questions of 01 marks with word limit 70-100 words each, short answer type questions will be 02 with 1.5 marks each and word limit 200-250 words each and 02 long answer type questions of 02 marks each ($2 \times 2 = 04$ marks) word limit 500-600 words.

for passing the internal test 10 marks collectively out of the three is mandatory.

10. Seminar - There will be provision of paper presentation and submission of paper. In above three components minimum passing marks will be 12 marks. And in practical subjects in theoretical papers 10 marks in above three components will be mandatory.

11. (a) Semester Examination. There would be four tier questions of 70 marks in Semester classes, in which objective 10 questions of 01 marks each ($10 \times 1 = 10$), short answer type 03 questions of 03 marks each ($03 \times 03 = 09$) word limit 70-100 words, short answer type 03 questions of 06 marks each ($03 \times 06 = 18$) word limit 200-250 words and 03 long answer type questions of 11 marks each ($3 \times 11 = 33$) word limit 500-600 words. All the question scheme will be with internal choice.

In Semester examination qualifying marks for each paper will be 25 and in internal test 12 marks and aggregate 40 marks in each paper compulsory for passing.

(b) In practical subjects, theoretical papers of 50 marks will have 04 tier question scheme in which objective type 08 questions of 01 marks each, 02 short answer type questions of 03 marks each ($2 \times 3 = 06$) word limit 70-100 words

short answer type 04 questions of 03 marks each
($4 \times 3 = 12$) word limit 200-250 words each and long
answer type questions of 08 marks each ($8 \times 3 = 24$) with
word limit 500-600. All the question schemes will be
accompanied with internal choice and theoretical papers
of practical subjects minimum 20 marks in each
paper and minimum 10 in internal and aggregate
30 in each paper is compulsory for passing the exam.

12. If a student on account of representing in sports,
NCC and NSS did not appear in the Unit test then
he/she will be awarded with the marks equal to the
marks obtained in the papers did not appear. But
if he/she has not appeared in any out of the two
tests then test of a Unit of that student will be
held separately. Excepting the students representing
NCC, NSS and sports, each unit test will not be held
for others.

Common Core Hindi and English Curriculum
of language of both the papers will be in accordance
to question scheme / separate question scheme
will be effective.

13. Grace Marks:- There will be no provision of
grace marks on account of execution of CBCS
system and in this system minimum passing
marks will be 40% percent.

14. Constitution of monitoring Committee for Internal
Test - There will be a monitoring committee in
each department in which Head of the Dept will be
Co-ordinator, one member from autonomous cell
and other teachers of the Dept. will work as member

but the Dept. where there are no regular faculty there a member from outside the college will be nominated as member. The test copies after evaluation will be shown to the students and the complaints received will be resolved before handing over the evaluation sheet to autonomous cell.

15. Revaluation/Recounting - There would be provision of revaluation in two subjects/papers and provisions of the recounting in all the papers of the concerned Semester.

16. Scheme for student - Teacher Guardian Scheme - Each Head of the Department in P.S. Classes and other teachers of the UG Classes of the faculty and there will a meeting held with Mother - Father of students of value added course and internship and information regarding Job will be collected. Rs 25/- as fee will be collected from regular student as environment fee for paper environmental studies out of which Rs 20 will be disbursed as honorarium remuneration for guidance and evaluation of project work. Remaining Rs. 05 will be distributed among controllers and official staffs.

17. (a) Eligibility for appearing in the Examination - 75% attendance in semester classes accompanied with passing distinctly in all the subjects/papers.

(b) Commencement of ATKIT Scheme - ATKIT Scheme of Semester scheme is implement from 2022-23. The student attained ATKIT will be promoted from first Semester to third semester with the backlog upto fourth Semester. All the examinations of ATKIT will be held

with the semester end exam of first/third semester and second/fourth semester. The ATKT exam of students of 3rd and 4th semester ATKT will be held in the next semester end exam of regular mode.

Grading together with marks percent will be mentioned on the Marks-Sheet. In the same way student with ATKT in VIIth and VIIIth semester will also have the opportunity of ATKT exam.

Students after clearing the ATKT will take TC from the college else they will not be allowed to appear in the ATKT examination. The student has to complete the programme in maximum 08 years.

18. Internship - Students together with their programme can select the field of their internship. A Cell of internship has been constituted for the purpose which will provide the students with firm and establishment for internship. The students have to submit the certificate of internship in internship cell.

19. Credit marks to be provided to students - All the students of first semester will obtain 01 credit for 01 period/01 working day. In practical 01 credit will be provided for 30 periods. In this way students have to obtain in curriculum 75% credit of the total credit i.e. 4.5 credit. In accordance to NEP 2020 there will be practicum in all theoretical papers; where 01 credit would be 15 hours. There will be peer teaching, Quiz, class seminar and field visit in practicum.

20. Credit Bank - In accordance to NEP 2020 there will a credit bank for students under which credit earned in each semester



will be there in credit bank which can be transferred and redeemed as required. The credit earned of each student with completion of syllabus will be deposited in credit bank.

21. Multi Entry and multi Exit - The student will have multi entry and multi exit opportunity under this scheme means student completing 01 year can leave his study and afterwards again start his study.

22. Examination application to be filled by the student - students will need to fill up exam form to appear in the examination for this they have to pass the internal test and 75% attendance. If a student stands fail in the internal test then he will not be eligible to appear in the semester end examination and if he/she is student of first semester, he/she will not be entitled for ATKT and he has to take re-admission in the same class and have to attain/obtain the minimum passing marks in internal test.

23. Moderation Board - Moderation board will examine the question paper before printing to ensure that the question should be for the syllabus and its language and pattern is appropriate.

Besides the above in case otherwise or odd situations provisions of st. Gauri Gurn Vishwanath Dyalaya, laid down in the ordinance will be abiding.

The decision taken unanimously regarding 04 years Undergraduate Honours with research areas follows:
The outline of 04 years (08 sem) Curriculum is as follows:

01. In 1st and second semester there will be three Discipline specific core (DSC), 01 Generic Elective (GE) is to be elected from basket, 01 Ability Enhancement Course (AEC), 01 Skill Enhancement Course (SEC) and 01 Value Addition Course (VAC) will be elected from basket. In AEC there will be four papers - Communication Skill in Hindi, Communication Skill in English, Environmental studies - I, Environmental studies - II, which will be taught in 1st, 2nd, 3rd, and 4th semester.
02. There will be 03 Discipline specific core (DSC), 01 Discipline Elective Course (DSE) or 01 Generic Elective (GE), 01 Ability Enhancement Course (AEC), 01 Skill Enhancement Course (SEC) and 01 Value Addition Course (VAC) will be selected from basket.
03. In 5th and 6th semester there will be 03 Discipline specific core course (DSC), 01 Discipline Elective Course (DSE), 01 Generic Elective (GE) and 01 Skill Enhancement Course (SEC).
04. In 7th and 8th semester 03 Discipline specific core course (DSC), 03 Discipline Elective Course (DSE) or 02 from DSE and 01 from GE or 03 from GE and dissertation will be implemented.
05. In seventh semester only those students will be eligible who collectively in all three semesters (03 years) have obtained 7.5 CGPA. The students obtaining

less than 7.5 CGPA will be provided 03 years degree.

Above from section 01 to 05 scheme and Curriculum will be implemented in accordance to List-01.

06. Certificate and degree scheme -

A - After completing two semesters (01 year) Course student will be eligible for Certificate.

(b) student will be awarded with diploma after completing four semester (02 years) Course.

(c) student will be awarded with graduate degree after completing six semester (03 years) Course.

(d) Honours degree with research will be awarded after completion of 08 semesters (04 years) Course.

07. Commencement of NCC and Law as subject -

From academic Session 2022-23 students enrolled as NCC cadet will opt NCC as generic Elective Paper and students of Arts and Science will opt Law as Generic Elective Paper.

08. There will be provision for on line studies on portal of UGC like MOODS and SWAYAM of subjects as available and portion of subject / paper studied online will not be taught physically in classroom, rather student on producing the certificate from portal and student will be provided with credit as well.

09. (a) - Internal assessment for non practical, theoretical papers - In theoretical subjects Semester end exam will be of 80 marks whereas internal assessment will be of 20 marks out of which internal test for 07 marks, Seminar 06 marks and assignment of 07 marks will be there. There

will be 02 tests, the first test will have 02 questions of 1.5 marks each in form of very short answer type questions, 01 question of short answer type questions of 04 marks with word limit of 200-250 words and will be held in 40 minutes of scheduled-period.

Assignment - It will be of three tier question pattern, in which very short answer type 02 questions of 0.5 marks each with word limit 70-100 words, short answer type 02 questions of 01 marks each with word limit 200-250 words and 02 long answer type questions 02 marks each comprising of 500-600 words.

(b) Internal assessment for practical subjects - In practical subjects semester end theoretical paper will be of 60 marks, internal assessment will be of 15 marks and practical of 25 marks. In internal assessment test, seminar and assignment will be of 05 marks each. There will be 02 tests. In first test there will be short answer type 02 questions of 01 marks each with word limit 70-100 words and 01 long answer type question of 03 marks with word limit 200-250 words and will be held in 40 minutes scheduled period. The second test will be of multiple choice question.

Assignment - In theoretical papers of practical subject Assignment will have three tier pattern where 02 questions will be 0.25 marks each with word limit 70-100 words, very short answer type questions, 02 short answer type question of 0.75 marks each with word limit 200-250 words and 02 long answer type questions carrying 1.5 marks each with word limit of 500-600 words.

∴ AEC, SEC and VAC, internal test for non practical

theoretical subject, - for theoretical papers semester and exam will be of 40 marks and three tier internal assessment maximum marks 10 marks out of which 04 marks for tests, 03 for seminar and 03 marks for assignment. There will be 02 tests in which the first test will have 02 short answer type questions of 01 marks each and 01 short answer type questions of 02 marks with 200-250 words will be there.

Assignment - Three tier question pattern will be there. There will be 02 short answer type questions of 0.5 marks each with word limit 70-100 words, 01 question of short answer type question of 0.75 marks with word limit 200-250 words and 01 long answer type question of 01 marks with word limit of 500-600 words.

(d) AEC, SEC and VAC internal assessment for practical subject - In practical subject's semester exam will be of 30 marks, internal test of 08 marks and practical of 12 marks. There will be 03 marks for tests, 02 for seminar and 03 for assignments. There will be 02 tests in which 02 questions of 0.75 marks with word limit 70-100 words of short answer type questions and 01 long answer type question of 1.5 marks with word limit 200-250 words. The second test will be multiple choice question.

10. Seminar - Paper presentation and submission.

11. (a) Semester exam in non practical subject - There will be for tier questions of 80 marks in which multiple choice questions of 01 marks, very short answer type 03 questions of 04 marks with word limit of 70-100 words, 03 short answer type questions of 02 marks with word limit 200-250 words and 03 long answer type questions of 11 marks

each. There will be internal choice. In semester exam 40% marks minimum in semester end and internal assessment will be mandatory.

(b) In theoretical subjects/papers of practical subjects there will be 04 tier question pattern in 60 marks paper, in which there will be 02 multiple choice questions of 01 marks each ($01 \times 02 = 02$), 03 short answer type questions of 05 marks each ($5 \times 3 = 15$) with word limit 200-250 words, 03 long answer type question of 09 marks each ($9 \times 3 = 27$) with 500-600 words. All the question scheme will have the internal choice and in the theoretical papers of practical subject minimum passing marks will be 30 marks in each paper including theoretical and internal marks in each paper.

(c) AEC, SEC and VAC, Semester exam for theoretical papers of nonpractical subjects - There will be four tier question scheme for total 40 marks has been ascertained in all the semester classes in which 07 multiple choice questions of 01 marks each ($1 \times 07 = 07$), 03 very short answer type questions of 02 marks each ($2 \times 3 = 06$) with word limit 70-100 words, 03 short answer type questions of 04 marks each ($4 \times 3 = 12$) with word limit 200-250 words and 03 long answer type questions of 05 marks each ($4 \times 3 = 12$) with word limit 500-600 words. All the question scheme will be along with internal option/choice.

The minimum passing marks in semester exam with sem end exam and internal tests will be minimum 20 marks.

(d) AEC, SEC and VAC, Sem exam for theoretical

Papers of Practical subjects - In theoretical papers of practical subjects there will be four tier question scheme of 30 marks in which 06 multiple choice questions of 01 marks each ($1 \times 6 = 06$), ⁰³ very short answer type questions of 01 mark each ($1 \times 3 = 03$) with word limit 70-100, 03 short answer type questions of 02 marks each ($2 \times 3 = 06$) with word limit of 200-250 words ^{and} 03 long answer type questions of 05 marks each ($5 \times 3 = 15$) with word limit 500-600 words. Minimum passing mark in each semester will be 20 marks collectively in Sem. I & II exam and internal test.

12. In account of participating in NSS and NCC activities and has appeared in one test then he will be awarded in second test the marks similar to earned in the first test but if he/she has not appeared in any test then one unit test of that paper will be held separately. Excepting NSS and NCC no separate test will be held in any other conditions.

Separate questions for Hindi and English language of common core course Hindi/English will be applicable in accordance to question scheme run by the University.

13. Grace Marks - There will be no grace provision in CBCS system as in this system minimum passing marks in each paper is 40 marks.

14. Constitution of Internal marks monitoring committee - There will an internal evaluation committee in each department and it will be comprised of S.O.D as chair person, one member from autonomous cell, and members of the dept. will be members of the committee.

- and the department which has no regular faculty, a teacher of the subject out of the college will be nominated as member. The students will be shown the test copy after evaluation and the complaint received in connection to internal marks before submitting to autonomous cell, Internal evaluation monitoring committee will be resolved.
15. There will be provision of reevaluation in maximum two subjects/papers and retotalling in all subjects/papers in the semester concerned.
16. Student teacher Guardian scheme - Each HOD in PG classes and other teachers of the dept in UG classes will be guardian who will collect information regarding value added course, internship, will hold meeting with parents of students and will compile all the information regarding job/ service/ Placement. Rs 25/- (Twenty five rupees) as fee out of which ^{Rs} 20/- rupees to teacher for guiding project work/field work as honourarium. Remaining Rs. 5 will be paid to controllers and officials of autonomous cell.
17. Eligibility to appear in the exam -
- 75% attendance in Semester Classes is mandatory.
 - Eligibility for Second Semester - Those who have appeared in and have back in 02 papers will be allowed to study and appear in Second Semester examination.
 - Eligibility for admission in Semester Three - The candidate should not have backlog in more than 02 papers in Semester - II. and Semester - III.
 - Eligibility for admission in Semester - IV - The candidate

should pass semester-I and have not more than 02 papers backlog in Sem II and III.

(e) Eligibility for admission in fifth semester - The candidate should pass all the papers of Sem-II and III and should not have backlog of more than 02 papers in Sem III and IV respectively.

(f) Eligibility for sixth semester - The candidate should pass all the papers of Sem I, II and III and should not have the backlog of more than 02 papers in IVth and Vth semester.

(g) The back papers of even semester will take place with the exam of even semester and odd semester's back paper with the exam of odd semester.

(h) If a student is pass in all the semesters excepting one subject/paper in Vth semester then that student will be provided with opportunity to appear in back paper with the exam of VIth semester.

(i) Eligibility for admission in VIIth semester - 7.5% CGPA upto VIth semester accompanied with passing all the subjects/papers.

(j) Eligibility for admission in VIIth semester - The candidates back in 02 subjects in VIIth semester will be eligible to appear in the exam of VIIIth semester. The back exam of VIIth semester will be held with the exam of VIIIth semester.

(k) Just after the completion of the VIIIth semester exam a special exam will be held for those who do not have back in more than 02 papers of VIIIth semester examination.

(l) In the beginning of the VIIth semester student will be directed to select honours subject in accordance to available seat. The

Students completing VIIIth semester successfully will be awarded with honors degree in their selected subject.

(m) If a student does not succeed in passing his back paper, he will be declared fail in the concerned sem. and he will be given the opportunity to appear as ex student in the forthcoming examination.

(n) for consideration of back paper both practical and theoretical papers will be included. Mark sheet will contain percentage of marks obtained together with grading.

18. After the completion of UG and PG semester examination list of three highest will be declared which have have minimum 60% marks atleast been obtained and the class/semester where no student obtains 60% marks, their merit list will not be declare.

19. Internship training / Apprenticeship / Project / Community Outreach - The students have to selecting one out of Internship Training / Apprenticeship / Project / Community outreach, and have to complete inbetween IIIrd to VIth semester.

20. Award of credit marks to students - The students for 1st semester in each paper will be provided 01 credit for 15 periods / 15 working day. In practical papers 01 credit will be provided for 30 periods. In this way 75% maximum credit (Theoretical and practical) i.e. (4.5) is mandatory to be obtained. In each theoretical paper according to NEP 2020 there is provision of practicum.

There will be 01 credit for 15 hours for it. Under practicum there will peer teaching, quiz, Class seminar, field visit.

21. Credit Bank According to NEP 2020 there will be

provision of credit bank which will maintain the credit earned in each semester which will either be transferred or redeemed as required. The credit earned with completion of curriculum will be deposited as credit in bank.

22- Multiple Entry and multiple exit - Under this scheme there will be multi entry and multi exit opportunity for students. Means a student completing 01 years study, can go leaving his study and after some time can resume the study.

23. Filling of application by students - Students have to apply for appearing in the semester exam. For appearing in semester exam 75% attendance is mandatory.

24. Moderation Board - Prior to printing of the question paper moderation board will examine the question paper and will ensure that the pattern of the paper is appropriate and it duly conforms to the syllabus.

Additional to above in case otherwise or in odd situation the provision inherent in ^{Ordinance of} Saint Gaura Gurn University, Surguja, Ambikapur will be applicable.

In the above meeting the decisions taken unanimously are as follows; regarding NEP 2020 in accordance to the provisions laid down by the UGC for 04 years honours with research, Undergraduate Old Course and regarding Post Graduation degree:

01. The curriculum prepared by different board of studies for NEP 20 and Post Graduate programmes have been approved.
02. The curriculum of NEP 2020 for 07 of 03/04 credit will

be of 100 marks and of 01/02 credit will be of 50 marks.

03. The students of OCA and PGDCA will be eligible for back in two subjects/four papers in the exam of Dec. 2023 as per the provisions of Government and the University.
04. In the Post Graduate and LLB courses also the odd semester ATKT Examination will be held with the examination of Odd Semester and Even Semester ATKT examination will be held with the Even Semester examination. The ATKT examination of the last semester will be held immediately after the semester examination.
05. In all the semesters of NEP 2020 the semester examination of VAC and SEC Papers will not be held. Their examination will be held with viva-voce examination of the practical exam.
06. Plant disease and treatment, Indian medicine etc VAC and SEC courses will be initiated under Indian Knowledge System.
07. In the old course IVth semester the provision of failure in more than 04 papers is being relaxed and the students fail in more than four papers including previous semesters should be provided admission in the next semester, the same provision will also be effective in fifth semester. But in the sixth semester the result will be declared only after passing all the previous back/ATKT examination. In the same way in LLB IVth semester students with ATKT are

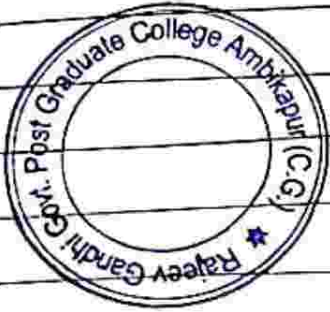
eligible to be admitted in Vth semester.

08. In accordance to the instructions of State Government and the provisions in practice in Universities and autonomous colleges the provision of revaluation in December 2023 examination is abolished. Yet at the time of retotaling the mistakes at prima facie the college will be able (have the power) to make the following rectifications:

- (a) If any question is not evaluated will be evaluated.
- (b) If the valuation is made and valuer has put the marks on the cover page of the Answerbook, but inside the answerbook the questions are ^{neither} ~~not~~ evaluated and marked separately nor marks are put on the cover page, in such condition the answerbook will be evaluated.
- (c) If the valuer has not evaluated stepwise the questions to be evaluated stepwise will be evaluated.
- (d) If the marks awarded by the valuer to different questions ~~do not~~ match with the marks mentioned on the cover page of the answerbook then valuation will not be made.

There will be only provision of retotaling for the students. There will be no provision of retotaling in back and ATKI examination. The photocopy of the answer

book will be provided after retotaling.
