Alumni Feedback Summary (Session 2022-23)

Introduction: This report summarizes the feedback collected from alumni regarding their experiences and perceptions of the college during the 2022-23 session. A total of 301 responses were analyzed to gauge sentiments on various aspects, including academic strengthening, involvement in college activities, new courses, recent developments, and overall pride in being part of the college.

1. Alumni's Role in Academically Strengthening the Direction

- **Total Responses:** 301
- **Response Breakdown:**
 - Strongly Agree: 106 (35.3%)
 - Agree: 162 (54.0%)
 - Neutral: 24 (8.0%)
 - Disagree: 4 (1.3%)
 - Strongly Disagree: 4 (1.3%)

Key Insights:

- A significant majority (89.3%) of respondents either strongly agree or agree that alumni play a crucial role in academically strengthening the college's direction.
- Only 2.6% of respondents expressed disagreement, indicating a strong consensus on the positive impact of alumni involvement.

2. Alumni Involvement in College Activities

- **Total Responses:** 301
- **Response Breakdown:**
 - Strongly Agree: 106 (35.3%)
 - Agree: 153 (51.0%)
 - Neutral: 29 (9.7%)



- Disagree: 6 (2.0%)
- Strongly Disagree: 6 (2.0%)

Key Insights:

- A total of 86.3% of respondents believe that the college effectively involves alumni in its activities.
- The neutral responses (9.7%) suggest some uncertainty regarding the extent of alumni engagement 5.

3. New Courses Meeting Contemporary Requirements

- **Total Responses: 301**
- **Response Breakdown:**
 - Strongly Agree: 104 (34.7%)
 - Agree: 164 (54.7%)
 - Neutral: 22 (7.3%)
 - Disagree: 3 (1.0%)
 - Strongly Disagree: 8 (2.3%)

Key Insights:

- An impressive 89.4% of respondents feel that the new courses introduced by the college meet contemporary requirements.
- A small percentage (3.3%) disagreed, indicating a generally positive reception of the new curriculum 4.

4. Recent Developments in the College

- **Total Responses: 301**
- **Response Breakdown:**
 - Strongly Agree: 117 (39.0%)
 - Agree: 144 (48.0%)
 - Neutral: 26 (8.7%)
 - Disagree: 6 (2.0%)
 - Strongly Disagree: 7 (2.3%)

Key Insights:

- A total of 87.0% of respondents appreciate the recent developments in the college.

- The neutral responses (8.7%) indicate some mixed feelings about these changes 3.

5. Student Pride in Being Part of the College

- Total Responses: 301
- Response Breakdown:
 - Strongly Agree: 162 (54.0%)
 - Agree: 122 (40.7%)
 - Neutral: 10 (3.3%)
 - Disagree: 0 (0.0%)
 - Strongly Disagree: 7 (2.0%)

Key Insights:


- An overwhelming 94.7% of respondents feel proud to be students of the college, reflecting a strong sense of identity and belonging 1.
