A meeting was held on 11/07/2023 in the Department of Law at 11:00 a.m. to discuss about the Slow and Advance Learners.

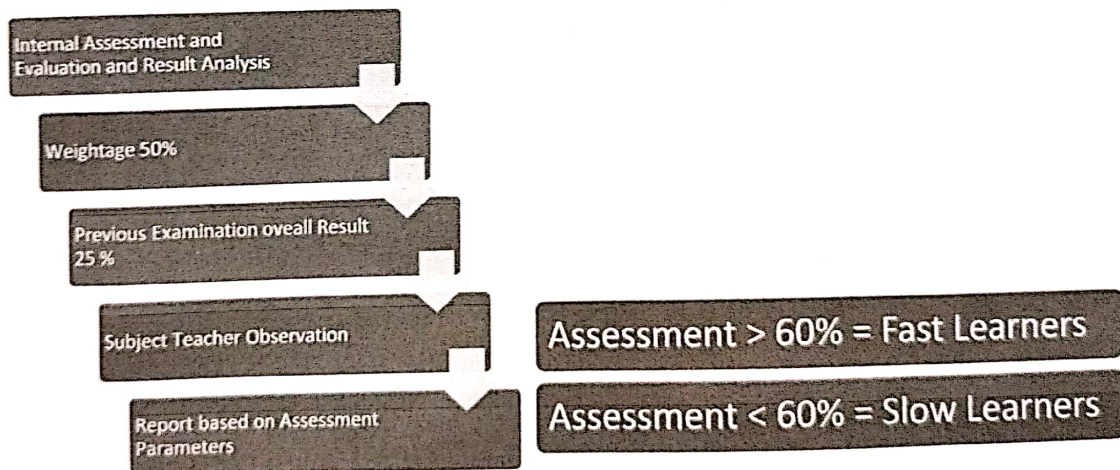
Slow Learners:

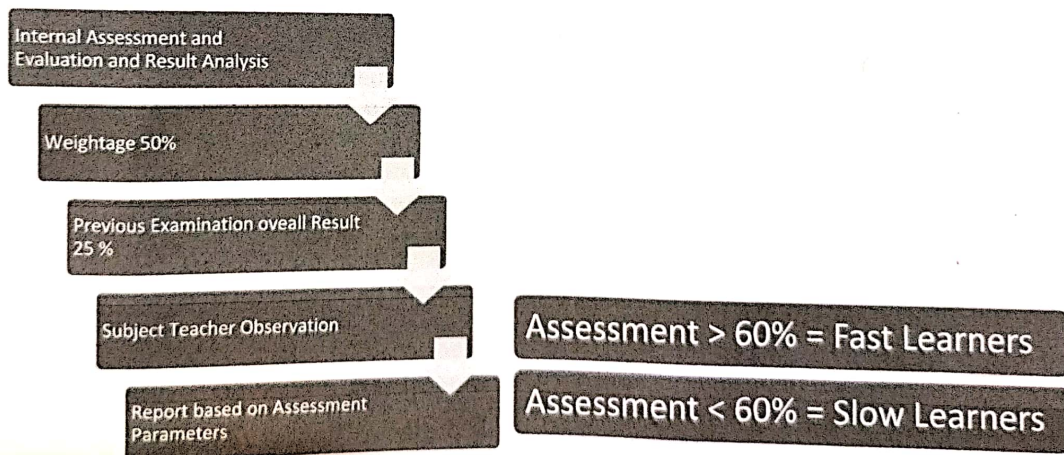

A meeting was held on 21/08/2021 in the Department of Law at 11:00 a.m. to discuss about the Slow and Advance Learners.

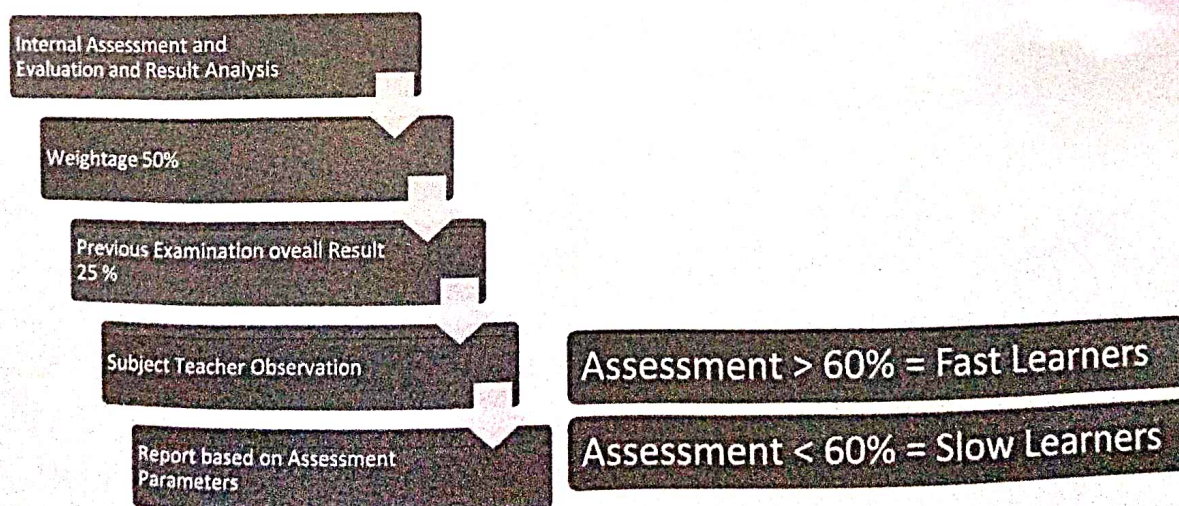
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Slow/Fast Learners Action Taken Report

A meeting was held on 28/09/2020 in the Department of Law at 11:00 a.m. to discuss about the Slow and Advance Learners.

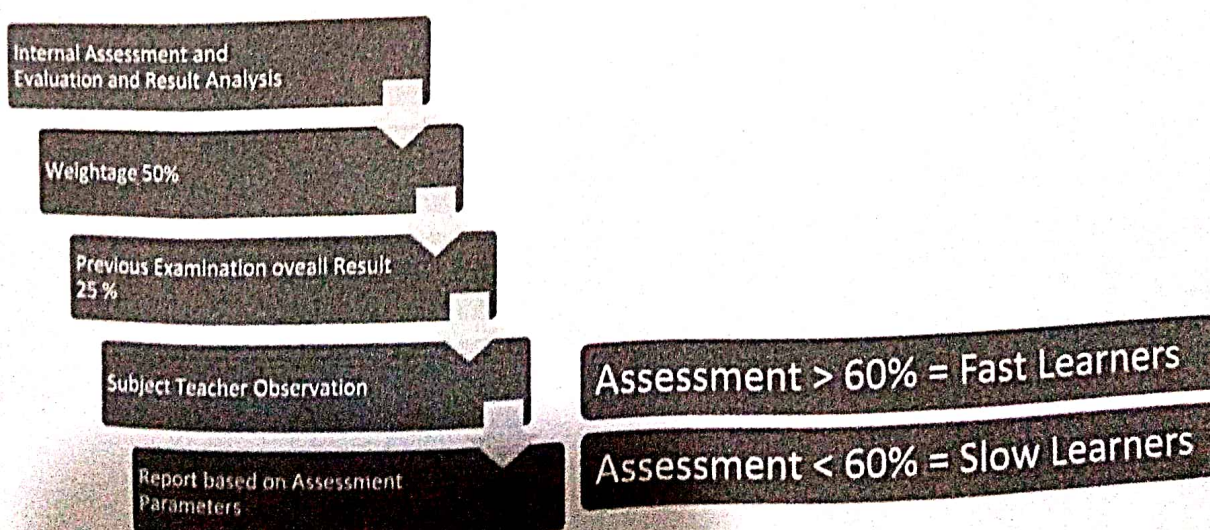
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Process of Identification for slow and Advance Learners



Actions for Advance students:

A meeting was held on 22/07/2019 in the Department of Law at 11:00 a.m. to discuss about the Slow and Advance Learners.

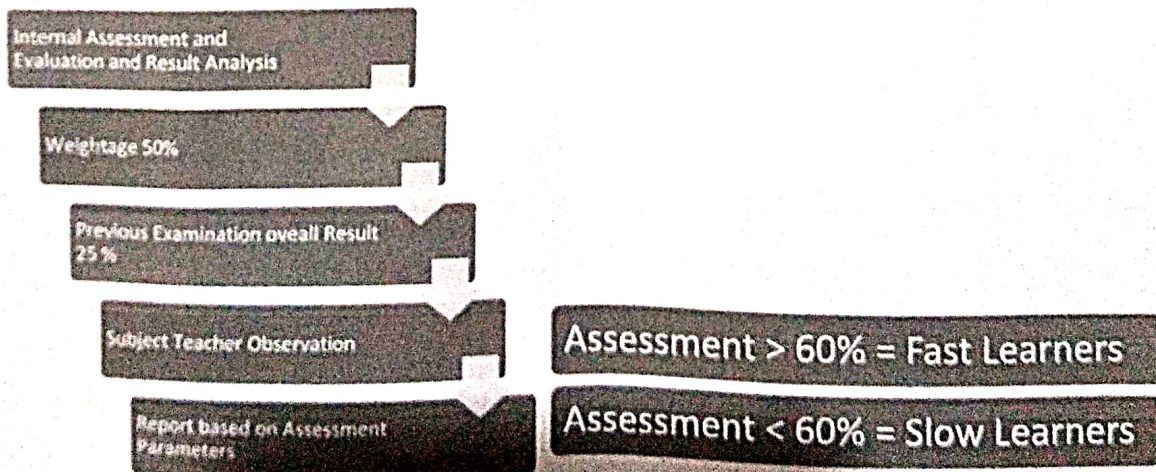
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

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Slow/Fast Learners Action Taken Report
