Overview:

A survey was conducted with 920 respondents to assess the course's performance in key areas such as content depth, coverage, real-life relevance, learning value, reading materials, and overall experience. The responses were categorized as Very Good, Good, Satisfactory, and Less Satisfactory, providing insights for course improvement.

Key Areas of Focus and Action Taken:

- 1. Depth of Course Content and Project Work:
 - Feedback:92.8% of respondents rated the course content as either Very Good (47.2%) or Good (45.6%).
 - Action Taken:
 - Retained the core structure of the course content due to high satisfaction.
 - Enhancements will be made to address the concerns of the 2.4% who rated
 it as Less Satisfactory, focusing on adding more up-to-date resources and
 practical applications in project work.
- 2. Extent of Coverage of Course:

- Additional workshops and skill-building exercises have been introduced to ensure students receive more hands-on learning opportunities.
- Special focus will be given to improving the experience for the 2.4% who rated the learning value as Less Satisfactory.

5. Clarity and Relevance of Textual Reading Material:

89.6% of respondents rated the clarity and relevance of reading materials as Very Good (41.2%) or Good (48.4%).

1. Teacher's Knowledge Base

96.4% of students rated the teachers as either "Very Good" or "Good" . 3.6% rated the teacher's knowledge as "Satisfactory."

Actions Taken:

- Organized professional development workshops to further enhance teachers' knowledge.
- Encouraged peer-learning groups to help teachers exchange expertise.
- Introduced periodic knowledge assessments for teachers to track improvement.

2. Communication Skills

92.7% of students rated communication as "Very Good" or "Good". 7.3% found communication "Satisfactory" or lower.

- Conducted communication skill enhancement training sessions.

88.2% of students rated teacher availability and motivation as "Very Good" or "Good." 11.9% found it "Satisfactory" or lower.

Actions Taken:

- Allocated dedicated office hours for teachers to ensure availability for student consultations.
- Teachers were encouraged to mentor students outside regular class hours to provide additional academic and motivational support.

Conclusion and Future Actions:

The overall feedback indicated high satisfaction with teacher performance in the 2022-23 academic year. However, areas such as enhancing knowledge base, communication, and generating interest require continuous attention. The institution will maintain regular feedback mechanisms and further refine professional development programs to ensure these improvements are sustained.
