Alumni Feedback Summary (Session 2023-24)

1. Career Usefulness of College Education

- Action The college should continue to focus on making the education more career-oriented and useful for students.
- Reasoning A significant majority of students (86.1%) find their college education useful in their careers. However, there is still a small percentage of students (5.0%) expressing dissatisfaction, which indicates the need for further improvement.

2. Effectiveness of New Courses

- Action The college should continue to introduce courses that meet contemporary requirements.
- Reasoning While a significant majority of students (82.8%) believe that the new courses introduced meet contemporary requirements, there is still a small percentage of students (4.2%) expressing dissatisfaction. This suggests the need for continuous improvement and alignment with current industry needs.

3. College Developments Appreciation

- Action The college should continue to focus on developments that are appreciated by the students.
- Reasoning A majority of students (77.8%) appreciate the recent developments in the college. However, there is still a smaller percentage of students (7.2%) expressing dissatisfaction, indicating the need to ensure that developments align with student expectations.

4. Alumni Involvement in College Activities

- Action The college should continue to effectively involve alumni in its activities.
- Reasoning A significant majority of respondents (86.6%) feel that the college is effectively involving alumni in its activities. However, there is still a small percentage of respondents (3.7%) expressing dissatisfaction, suggesting the need for further engagement strategies.

5. Alumni's Role in Academic Strengthening

- Action The college should continue to involve alumni in academically strengthening the college.
- Reasoning A significant majority of respondents (81.5%) believe that alumni have a role to play in academically strengthening the college. However, there is still a small percentage of respondents (4.4%) expressing disagreement, indicating the need for more effective communication and collaboration with alumni.

6. Department-wise Alumni Associations

- Action The college should continue to support the formation of department-wise alumni associations.



- Reasoning A significant majority of respondents (85%) support the formation of department-wise alumni associations. However, there is still a small percentage of respondents (3.7%) expressing disagreement, suggesting the need for further communication and engagement regarding the benefits of such associations.

7. College Administration and Alumni Association

- Action The college administration should take initiative to efficiently enroll and strengthen the alumni association.
- Reasoning A significant majority of respondents (85.9%) believe that the college administration should take initiative to efficiently enroll and strengthen the alumni association. This indicates strong support for proactive measures in this regard.
